Jewelry Making

Women are taught jewelry-making, also how to use this skill as an empowerment tool to produce income.

They learn to make bracelets, earrings and necklaces to begin. If you have a jewelry or beading project you can teach, you can positively impact or change many lives.



RONI WALKER HOUSE



This ministry tool houses our wood-work shop, boat building and repair site, sewing center, jewelry-making and craft center. Upstairs houses two one-bedroom apartments. These will be used for housing short-term missionaries, pastors, trainers and interns, as they share in missions. Help us complete the upstairs apartments of this needed building.

Come build a skiff like this one and donate it to a family; teach wood work skills to men; build lobster traps, fish pots, shelves, book cases, cabinets, picnic benches, chairs, tables and tourist items.

We also need the following tools:

150 psi air compressor

High speed steel/wood lathe

Wood working band saw

16' variable speed scroll saw

6" x 48" and 9" disc combination sander

Heavy duty 16 speed floor drill press

120 amp, 230 volt mig & flux welder





COMMERCIAL FISHING PROJECT

Because of the lack of jobs on the island, Karazim is developing a program which creates jobs not dependant on the tourist industry. Karazim's commercial fishing project teaches and trains men to properly harvest the bounty of the sea. Properly trained and equipped, a man can care for his family year round.



We are also helping to control the lion fish population by building a commercial market for the use and sales of the species.

God's Gardens

The greatest need in our ministry remains feeding the hungry. As daily feeding becomes more and more expensive, we began developing above-ground gardens in the villages. This has helped considerably to provide good nutrition and food for families, they would not be able to afford because all such items are imported to

Grand Bahama. The success of these above-ground gardens has led to the development of a 9 acre farm to help grow food for ministry also to help employ locals. This project will continue to help with the development of above-ground gardens in the villages while growing vegetables, citrus, and talapia for

the commercial market. This way the farm can become self sufficient, providing employment, food and an evangelistic outreach.

Lots of help needed in all areas of farming and farm equipment.





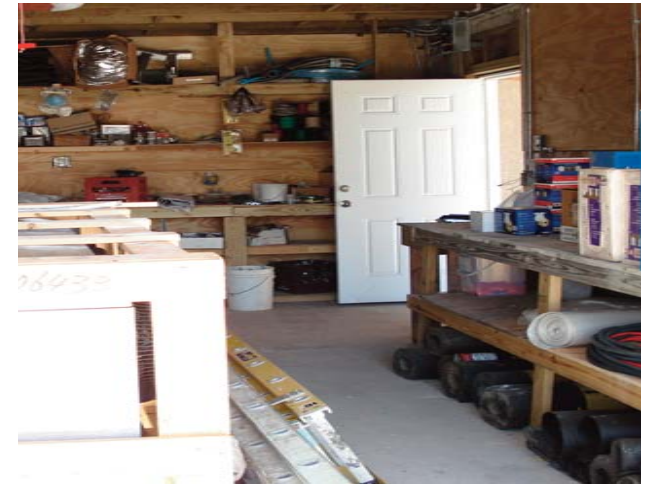
FEEDINGS and distribution



We feed up to 180 persons daily when resources are available. The elderly, and children are priority. Feedings take place in the form of cooked food delivered daily, mass distributions at outdoor services and rallies and community distribution is done by the bus load. We also distribute clothing, toiletries and linens. We are always in need of non-perishable food, and funds to purchase daily meats and produce. Coming and helping via short-term missions will be such a blessing to you and all recipients.



CONSTRUCTION

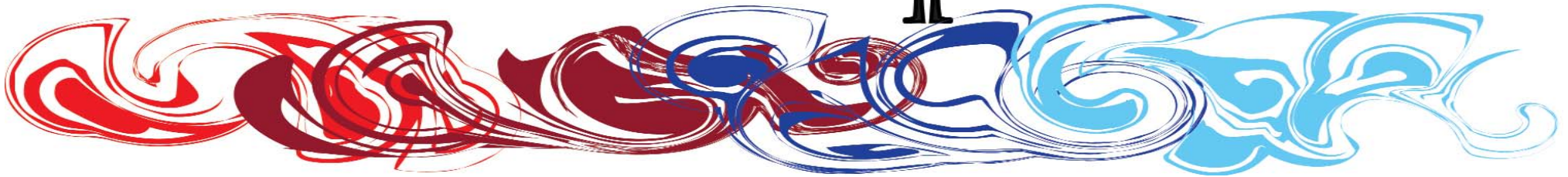

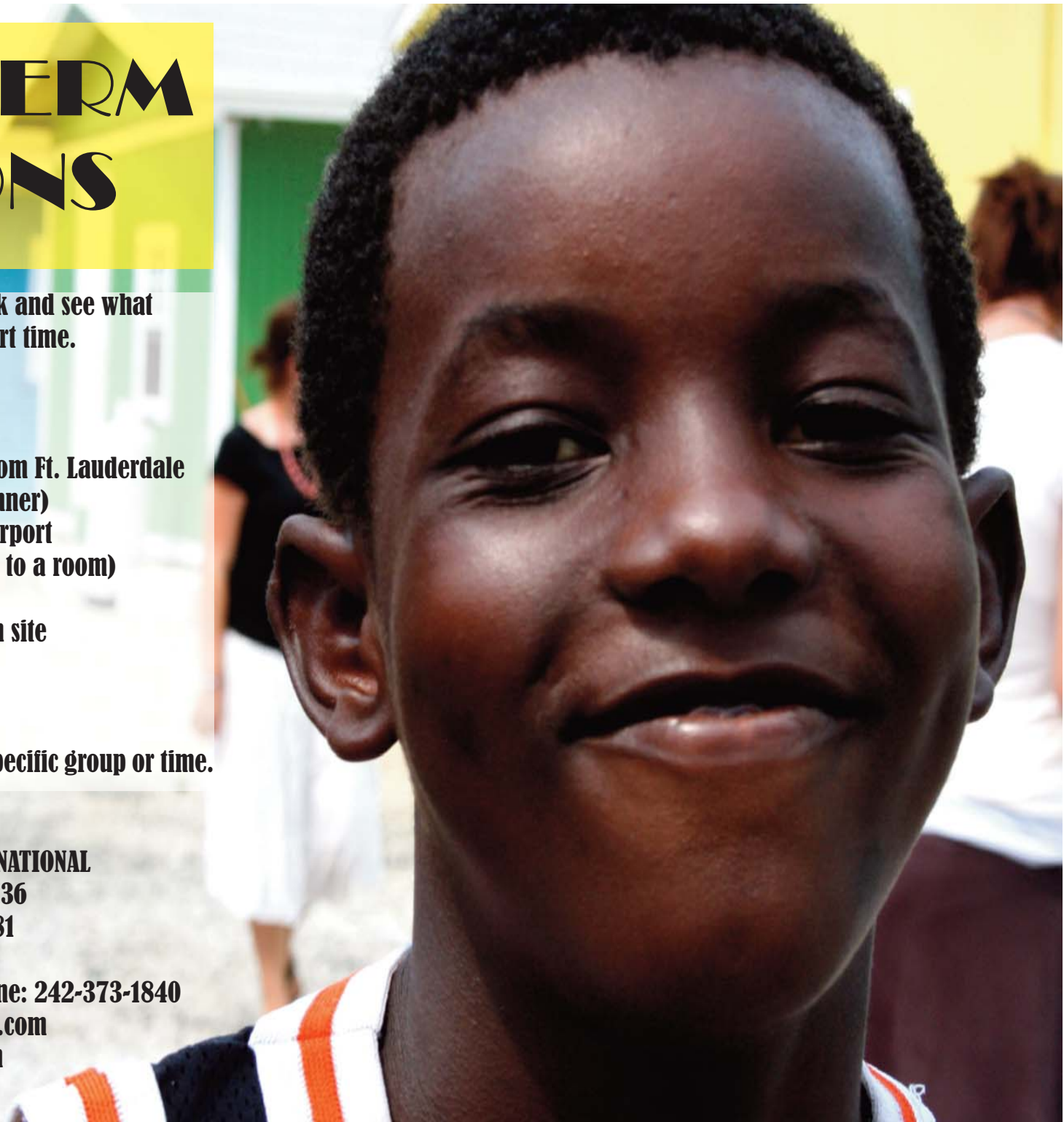
